Open Public Hearing for Local Law to Amend the Zoning Code the Town of Leicester, Livingston County, New York to Modify Article VI, Section 609C: Supervisor Fanaro opened the Public Hearing at 7:01 p.m. and will leave open for half hour. Public Notice was presented to each Councilmember and Supervisor. This was presented to the Livingston County Planning Board as well.
